## Jérôme Lejeune To the Least of These **My Brothers & Sisters**

Dr. Jérôme Lejeune, physician, geneticist, and researcher, gained international fame through his discovery of the cause of Down syndrome, with the team of Professor Turpin in 1958.

With his discovery, he changed the perceptions of people with Down syndrome, who flocked to his medical practice by the hundreds. He had only one obsession: to someday find a cure for his patients, who he referred to as "his little ones."

In 1969, he received the William Allen Memorial Award in San Francisco from the American Society of Human Genetics, the highest award a geneticist could receive. There, he delivered a speech defending the dignity of the human embryo causing an earthquake among his colleagues. He was aware that his discovery had opened the door to the abortion of children with genetic anomolies, and he dedicated his life to searching for a cure, and fighting against this trend - both in a heroic effort to defend the lives of those he loved so dearly.

20 years after his death, the director, François Lespes probes the character of the man and his unexpected fate. His presentation of this amazing personality can leave no one indifferent, and challenges its viewers to consider their own commitment to serving their conscience in the defense of human life. Jerome Lejeune to the least of these presents a great man of science who never turned aside from his beliefs, regardless of the personal cost.

This DVD presents the documentary with English voices dubbed over the French. Also included are versions in French and with Spanish subtitles. Also included is a bonus collection of additional recollections by his friends, family, and former colleagues who reflect on his faith, his varied interests and talents, and ultimately his profound humanity.
